	We ask that parents or legal guardians bring their children into the building, but do not go up
	to the 3rd floor. Please escort them to the 2nd floor and they will be guided to their classroom
	Every Saturday, upon entrance to the building, we will be taking everyone's temperature. It is
	encouraged to do this prior to leaving your home as well.
	Throughout the day, please be advised that we will perform random temperature checks.
	Every Saturday, upon entrance to the building, we will be offering hand sanitizer to everyone.
	Please let us know if you have any allergies to alcohol-based hand sanitizers, latex, etc.
	Please wear a mask indoors regardless if vaccinated or not.
	Please adhere to all of our internal social distancing measures. We will have markings
	throughout the occupied floors.
	Please do not come to the building if you have any <u>COVID-19 symptoms</u> . Attendance will not
	be affected. We strongly encourage everyone to familiarize themselves with what these
	symptoms are. See link above.
	Should you not have a mask, we will provide you with one.
	We will not provide snacks throughout the day. Please make sure your child brings a sufficient
	amount of water, lunch, and snacks.
	Please let us know if you are vaccinated. This information will be kept confidential.
